### A CONCEPTUAL STUDY ON THE ROLE OF KSHARA DASHAKA KSHARASUTRA IN TREATMENT OF BHAGANDARA WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO FISTULA IN ANO

### ABSTRACT

Bhagandara is one of the Ashtamahagadha. Bhagandara causes a tear in the region of bhaga (perineum), guda (rectum) and basti (pelvis). Those which do not burst open are called pidaka (Bhagandara pidaka). While the one which burst open are Bhagandara. Bhagandara can be correlated to fistula in ano. A fistula is an abnormal connection between two epithelial lined surfaces. The incidence of a fistula-in-ano developing from an anal abscess ranges from 26% to 38%. One study showed that the prevalence of fistula-in-ano is 8.6 cases per 100,000 population. In men, the prevalence is 12.3 cases per 100,000 population, and in women, it is 5.6 cases per 100,000 population. The male-to-female ratio is 1.8:1. The mean patient age is 38.3 years. Kshara Sutra therapy is a minimal invasive Ayurvedic Parasurgical procedure and time-tested Ayurvedic technique in the management of Anal Fistula. It is a safe, sure and cost effective method of treatment for fistula-in ano. The present study aims to explore the effect of Kshara Dashaka Ksharasutra in the management of Bhagandara.

### INTRODUCTION

The word *Bhagandara* is combination of two words i.e., bhaga and dharana. Bhaga means all the structures around the Guda (ano-rectal region) including Yoni (in case of females Basti (urinary bladder). Word dharana means tear of the surface. Acharya Sushruta described 'Bhagandara' as one of the Mahagadas due to its grave nature. [1] Due to indulgence in *Apathya ahara* and *vihara* vata dosha gets dushita and gets localized in the area around the anus, with in 1 to 2 angulas. Later it vitiates mamsa and raktha dhatus, after getting combined with other 2 doshas and produces features as per predominance of doshas. If this condition is untreated, leads to suppuration. Even after suppuration if Apathya sevana is continued produces Bhagandara. Bhagandara produces lakshanas like pitika, toda, raga, visrava etc. Bhagandara can be correlated to fistula in ano in contemporary science. The term fistula is derived from the Latin word meaning "of reed, pipe, or flute." The treatment of Fistula in Ano has evolved over a period with various modifications in its surgical management starting from simple fistulotomy to advanced treatments like Video Assisted Anal Fistula Treatment (VAAFT), Endorectal advancement flap, Fibrin plug, Ligation of Itersphinctric Fistula Tract (LIFT). Ayurveda advocates

application of *Ksharasutra* in *Nadi vrana Chikitsa.*<sup>[2]</sup> *Ksharasutra* has been used and researched by various Ayurveda proctologists, and is standardized over the years. *Apamarga Ksharasutra* is been widely used in its management. However, many *Ksharasutras* have been prepared by different *Kshariya Dravyas* for the effective management in *Bhagandara*. *Kshara Dashaka* is a group of ten alkali producing drugs mentioned in *Rasatarangini* and *Raja Nighantu*. <sup>[4]</sup> The text says:

The effect of individual drugs mentioned in the above reference in treating *bhagandara* are observed, but the combined effect which is enhanced by virtue of combination has not been explored. Hence the study if produces intended results will be a golden opportunity for Ayurveda surgeons community to have a *kshara* that can be produced with ample raw materials at hand. This study is intended to find whether *Kshara Dashaka Kshara* Sutra is parallel to *Apamarga Kshara Sutra*.



### Ksharadashaka Ksharasutra Preparation

All ten kshara dravyas are taken in equal quantity and are burnt together.



One drona of ash is taken and mixed with 6 drona of water<sup>[7]</sup> is added to it and kept for 12 hours undisturbed.





20 number barber thread taken, applied with 7 coats of Snuhi ksheera.



After proper drying 11 coats of Kshara dashaka kshara is applied.



After proper drying and uniform thickness, ksharadashaka ksharasutra is obtained.

# Management Of *Bhagandara*Procedure of *Ksharasutra* application *Purvakarma*

- Patient is given *Laghu snigdha ahara* and 10 g of *Triphala choorna* as laxative at bed time.
- Inj.Xylocaine 2% test dose is given intradermally.
- Inj.TT 0.5 ml/IM is given,
- BP enema is given.

### Pradhana karma

Patient is placed in lithotomy position. Under all aseptic precautions, part prepared followed by painting and draping of the part. A suitable malleable probe is forwarded along the path of least resistance and guided by the finger with lubrication in the anal canal to reach into its lumen. Then the tip is finally directed to come out of the anal orifice through the internal opening in the anal canal. A suitable length of plain thread is taken and threaded in the eye of the probe. Thereafter the probe is pulled out through the anal orifice, to leave the thread behind in the fistulous tract. The two ends of the plain thread then be tied together with a moderate tightness outside the anal canal. This procedure is called primary threading. On the 7<sup>th</sup> day, primary thread is replaced by using Kshara Dashaka Ksharasutra sutra by adopting rail-road method.

### Pashchath karma

Sitz bath with warm *Panchavalkala kwatha*<sup>[8]</sup> twice daily is advised and *Triphala Choorna*<sup>[9]</sup> 10g with warm water at bed time are prescribed. Later on every subsequent 7<sup>th</sup> day, new *Kshara Dashaka Ksharasutra* is changed until the fibrous tract is completely cut and healed.

### DISCUSSION

Probable Mode Of Action Of Kshara Dashaka Ksharasutra: Ksharadashaka contains 10 drugs producing kshara and varying doshahara properties. Shigru, Moolaka, Palasha, Chukrika, Chitraka, Ardraka and Apamarga have ushna guna, katu rasa pradhana and predominently either tridoshahara or vatakaphahara in nature. Nimba, Ikshu and Kadali moola have

sheetaveerya, madhura rasa and predominantly kapha pittahara in nature. Ksharadashaka applied on the thread allows chemical curettage of the fibroses and unhealthy granulation tissue. The presence of proteolytic enzymes is capable for its corrosive, caustic, anti-microbial and bactericidal properties. Haridra causes vasodilation when applied on the mucous membrane, possess anti-inflammatory, analgesic effect. It also has Kushtghna<sup>[10]</sup> and Vranashodhaka-ropaka properties which contribute to proper cutting and healing of the tract. Kshara sutra not only cuts the tissue, but also does continuous drainage of the wound, which enables to lay the track open.

### CONCLUSION

The study is intended to explore the efficacy of Ksharadashaka ksharasutra due to the following reasons

- 1. Drugs constituting *Kshara Dashaka* are abundantly available everywhere.
- 2. Collection of *Kshara Dashaka* can be done in all seasons.
- 3. Apart from yielding *Kshara*, drugs constituting *Kshara Dashaka* have excellent wound healing property.
- 4. Apart from yielding *Kshara*, drugs constituting *Kshara Dashaka* have *Tridoshahara* property.

Hence, *Kshara Dashaka Kshara Sutra* can be at par with Apamarga Kshara Sutra and has been taken up for study.
